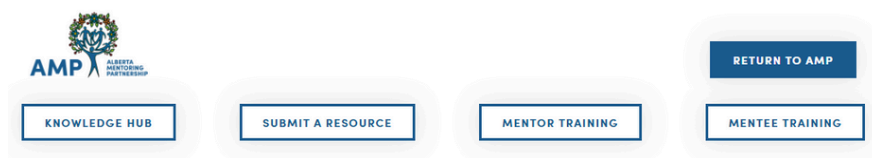

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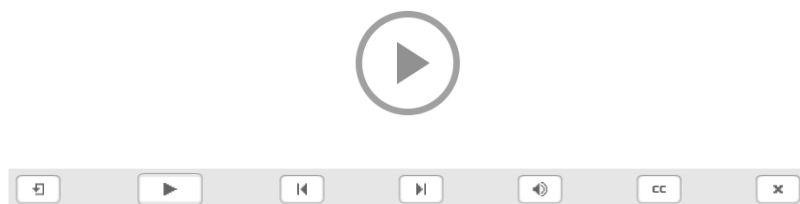

Module One: Knowledge Check

In this orientation, you learned about the essential role of mentoring in supporting children and youth. Key points include:

- **Definition of Mentoring:** Mentoring involves caring individuals providing support, advice, and positive role modeling to young people over time.
- **Importance of Mentoring:** You discovered how mentoring fosters healthy relationships that enhance brain development and overall well-being in youth.
- **Building Positive Relationships:** You were introduced to the dynamics of creating effective mentoring relationships, emphasizing connection and trust.
- **Your Role as a Mentor:** You gained insight into what is expected of you as a mentor and the support available from your mentoring program.
