




- For individuals wishing to enroll to the mentor training, click "No" to the question about mentoring organization. For agency or school admins, click "Yes"



What You Will Learn


The orientation introduces mentors to the core concepts of mentoring and what it means to be a mentor.

The program includes 5 modules and a check for understanding:

- The basics of mentoring
- The importance of mentoring
- The role of the mentor
- The support you can expect from your mentoring program
- Introduction to the dynamics of building a positive mentoring relationship



- Each module has a lesson and a knowledge check/quiz
- Navigate through modules using the sidebar



• Each lesson has a video you are required to finish in order to answer the quiz

• Click on the play button to watch the video. There are also buttons for play, next, previous, closed captions, and exit at the bottom.



After watching a video in module, click the "Next Module" button to answer the quiz



• At the start of each quiz, click on the "Start Review" button

Module One: Knowledge Check


In this orientation, you learned about the essential role of mentoring in supporting children and youth. Key points include:

- Definition of Mentoring: Mentoring involves caring individuals providing support, advice, and positive
 role modeling to young people over time.
- Importance of Mentoring: You discovered how mentoring fosters healthy relationships that enhance brain development and overall well-being in youth.
- Building Positive Relationships: You were introduced to the dynamics of creating effective mentoring relationships, emphasizing connection and trust.
- Your Role as a Mentor: You gained insight into what is expected of you as a mentor and the support
 available from your mentoring program.

As you embark on this journey, remember that your time and guidance can make a significant difference in a young person's life!
